



BETTY AND GLENN TRIBE SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose: To provide college tuition assistance for students with plans to pursue a Mechanical Engineering Degree

Eligibility: Students selected to receive the scholarship must:

- be graduating seniors from high schools within the Battle Ground or Ridgefield school districts and have met the entry requirements for admittance to Clark College or Washington State University **OR**
- be a current student at Clark College or Washington State University (Pullman or Vancouver campus)

The annual scholarship award, for each of the customary four years of college, is based on continued successful achievement of course requirements, and must be reapplied for each year. Returning award recipients will be given preference.

Prior to the final awards being made, if requested, applicants must be willing to meet with the Betty and Glenn Tribe Scholarship Advisory Committee or a representative of the Community Foundation, at the Vancouver, WA office.

Amount: \$1,000.00 minimum (for each of the customary four years of college). Multiple Scholarships may be awarded

Deadline: Your application, letters of recommendation, official sealed transcript and other attachments must be received on or before **April 30, 2012.**
