Selection Criteria

The annual First Citizen Award is presented to a Clark County resident who has modeled exemplary citizenship through actions and service to the community.

Recipients are chosen for their accomplishments and contributions to the community in the following areas:

- ◆ Effectiveness in leadership roles.
- ◆ Raising community standards and expectations.
- ◆ Exemplary giving of time, self and resources.
- ◆ Strengthening community identity and civic pride.
- ◆ Expanding and improving the provision of community services.
- ◆ Fostering public involvement and volunteerism.
- ◆ Preservation, development and/or improvement of community assets and amenities.
- ◆ A long-term record of service, though short-term efforts could be recognized depending on the situation.
- ◆ Service in conjunction with employment is valid for consideration; commitment going beyond the job will be the determining factor.

A volunteer committee of community leaders and past recipients of the First Citizen Award selects the recipient. The First Citizen Award has been presented annually since 1939.
