- > Drawing Donors: Give More 24! aims to grow the pie of local giving. The total number of donors has grown each year, but this year's 19% increase was our largest jump since 2015.
- > Peer-to-Peer Power: 167 champions led personal fundraising campaigns on behalf of their favorite nonprofits, netting an additional 609 donors and \$73,891 of support for 56 nonprofits.
- > Matches Maximized: In total, donors fulfilled 97% of the available match dollars, boosting the efforts of 109 participating nonprofits.
- > Facebook Frenzy: We saw a fantastic 3% uptick in engagement on Facebook, the source of nearly 90% of our social media traffic to givemore24.org.


