Key Takeaways

- This year, we increased our goal for total funds raised by 33% or \$500,000.
 Amid a pandemic, donors came out in force, hitting our \$2 million goal by 5 p.m.
- Peer-to-peer fundraisers added an average of nearly 8 donors per campaign, accounting for nearly 21% of donors and \$193,370 in donations.
- Nonprofits secured matching gifts to double donations, and donors successfully fulfilled 95.4% of the available matching funds.
- Live segments, virtual events and giveaways helped double total reach and engagement on social media.



Nonprofit Performance

- → 225 nonprofits supported (33% increase from 2019)
- → 333 matching gifts procured by 115 nonprofits
- → Average raised per nonprofit was \$12,895
- Average raised by nonprofits with peer-to-peer fundraiser campaigns was \$24,219
- Average raised by nonprofits with a match was \$22,151
- → 21% of nonprofits were new participants
- Hosted 24 virtual and socially distanced events during a pandemic
