The Takeaway

Following a historic, record-setting year, it was hard to say what Give More 24! could accomplish in 2021. The relentless grip of COVID-19 put strains on nonprofit capacity and funding. As a result, fewer nonprofits were able to participate in the event. Yet, those that showed up were deeply committed and set even higher expectations. On average, these incredible nonprofits managed to engage more donors per organization. Speaking of donors, those who contributed were more generous than ever.

Together, these extra efforts pushed Give More 24! over its fundraising goal for the fifth straight year. It took until the eleventh hour, but again this community proved what is possible when we all give more at the same time. To date, Give More 24! has now helped nonprofits raise more than \$12 million and inspired more than 50,000 gifts to local causes. Every last gift and every single dollar has added to the Boundless impact our local nonprofits create in Southwest Washington.

Nonprofit Performance


- 207 nonprofits supported


